ABOUT THE CLUB

HRYC was established over 127 years ago by thirteen Daytona sailors who loved racing their gaff-rigged catboats on the Halifax River. Back in 1896, they built a clubhouse on a wharf 150 feet long and 8 feet wide, across from property owned by Laurence Thompson, one of the founders. Over the years, the original club house grew, and more docks were added as members discovered the good times to be had along the Halifax River.

BAR OR LOUNGE

Beverages are available from 11:00 a.m. until closing. Drinks sold at the Club may only be consumed in the Clubhouse and on contiguous Club property.

No Minors Allowed at the Bar.

HRYC is a smoke free Club. A smoking area is provided on the east end of the parking garage.

GRATUITIES

A service charge of 20% is added to all food and bar checks at HRYC.

If you wish, an additional tip may be given to any staff member.

PAYMENT

FCYC member's bills will be sent to their club. Other visitors may pay with a credit card.

ATTIRE

Lunch: Casual dress – shorts, sports or boating attire may be worn in the Flag Room at lunchtime.

Dinner: Casual dress [Jacket and tie optional] except for special events.

No one permitted in Clubhouse without shirt and shoes or in a bathing suit.

Gentlemen, please, no hats/caps permitted inside any Club Dining Room or at the Bar.

CELL PHONES/ COMMUNICATION DEVICE

Cell phones are PROHIBITED in the club house, please put your COMMUNICATION DEVICES IN THE SILENT MODE AND RECEIVE CALLS OUTSIDE.

IDENTIFICATION

Visitors must identify themselves by presenting a current membership card or a letter of introduction from their club.

RECIPROCITY

Florida Council of Yacht Club (FCYC) members receive full reciprocity including charge privileges. Yachting Clubs of America (YCA), Motor Trawlers Owners Association (MTOA) and other reciprocal organizations receive Transient Dockage, Dining and Facility reciprocity and may settle their charges with a credit card.

CAR ARRIVAL

From I-4 or I-95, exit at U.S. 92 east. Drive east on International Speedway Blvd. (U.S. 92); turn right onto South Beach Street (before the river). We are located 2 stoplights down, corner of Beach St. and Orange Ave., on the south side of the Fire Station. Parking can be found on the south side of fire station parking lot or across the street (corner of Live Oak and Beach Street).

SLIP RESERVATIONS

Advance reservations for dockage are required as space is limited. Check out time is 12:00 noon unless other arrangements have been made.

MARINA

We can accommodate up to 75' LOA vessels at HRYC and 3 transient's slips are available. A floating dock for smaller boats adjoins the seawall. The Dockmaster is on duty Monday through Sunday, 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. and may be reached on VHF Ch.68 or at (386) 290-9454. Showers, ice and laundry facilities are available at the Clubhouse.

BOAT ARRIVAL

The Yacht Club is located adjacent to the Halifax Harbor Marina just south of the Memorial Bridge (Orange Ave.) on the west side of the Halifax River. Long/Lat. N.290 12' 30" W 81° 1' 0". The channel is narrow but well-marked. At low tide it can be shallow.

DOCKS

Docks must be kept free and clear at all times. Please coil lines, power lines and hoses neatly.

NO OPEN FIRES OR BAR-B-QUES ON WOOD DOCKS!!!!

REPAIRS

Non-members are not permitted to employ anyone other than members of their own crew for minor repairs and maintenance while docked at the Club, except in emergencies. Arrangements for other work must be made with local boat yards or approved on site contractors, please see the Dockmaster for assistance.

VEHICLES

A dock cart for transporting gear and supplies to and from boats are located on each dock and are secured with a latching cable. No gas or electric vehicles are permitted to operate on the docks.

WASTE

Garbage and trash must be tied in plastic bags and deposited in containers ashore. A receptacle is provided at the dock entrance and the entrance to the parking lot.

PETS

All pets must be on a leash when ashore. Pets, except for service dogs, are not allowed in the clubhouse or Tiki area. There is a dog walk area on the south side of the docks. Owners are responsible for cleaning up after their pets.

PICKLEBALL

Four Pickleball Courts located at 346 South Beach Street across from the main clubhouse belong to HRYC and may be utilized by visiting boaters. The HRYC players usually gather on Tuesday, Thursday and Sunday Mornings but the courts can be used other times as well. Just ask the docks staff for more information.

ABOUT HISTORIC DAYTONA

If you want to stretch your legs, walk (or shop) your way north up Beach Street into the restored Historic Downtown. Enjoy the unusual Art Deco buildings, browse through the unique shops and antique malls, stroll through the newly renovated Riverfront Esplanade and check out the local memorabilia at the Halifax Museum. A favorite with most boaters is touring Angell and Phelps and watching chocolates made by hand the old fashioned way. Don't miss it, chocolate is almost a cruising necessity. And it's on the way back to the boat!

FARMERS MARKET

From HRYC turn north on S. Beach Street and take a left on Magnolia Ave. Located near the Jackie Robinson Ballpark on City Island (Open Saturday mornings 7 am – 12 pm).

PUBLIC LIBRARY

1 block North, East of S. Beach Street or take a short cut through the Farmer's Market and Library parking lot. If you want "take with you books" there is a used book store on S. Beach Street and a huge one, Abraxas Books, one block West of Beach at 127 International Speedway Blvd. West. HRYC also has a lending library in the Boaters Lounge.
