**RULES AND EXPECTED BEHAVIOR**

***Please be sure your child reads and understands this information.***

1. **NO STUDENT IS ALLOWED ON DOCKS OR BOATS WITHOUT U.S.C.G.A. PFD (LIFE JACKET) ON AND ZIPPED. TYPE III IS RECOMMENDED.**
2. Proper footwear will be worn at all times, both on land and on the water.
3. No one is allowed on docks without supervision.
4. No littering on land or water. Boats and sailing area must be kept “ship-shape”.
5. Personal property is the responsibility of the student and not Halifax River Yacht Club or the Sailing Instructors. No electronic devices allowed on the docks or boats, i.e. cell phones, iPods, etc.
6. No eating or chewing gum during sailing activities.
7. No pushing, shoving, running, hitting, profanity. No disruptive behavior, disrespectful gestures, actions or language.
8. No jumping off boats without instructor’s permission. If they say you can swim, it is important to stay near your boat so you can easily get back in and so that it doesn’t drift away or go up on the rocks.
9. Stay in the area where the instructors and other students are, unless you ask the instructor’s permission to leave.
10. Our **DISCIPLINE POLICY** (pg. 2) is strictly upheld. Every sailor is accountable for his/her actions. Be sure the policy is read and understood.

**DISCIPLINE POLICY**

Our discipline policy maintains that each sailor will have three chances to correct any non-rule following behavior as follows:

1. First “strike”, your parent will be called by the instructor and the transgression will be reported. This will be recorded on your file and the Program Director will be notified.
2. Second “strike”, you and your parents will be asked to meet with the instructor and the Program Director to discuss the first and second transgression and to make a plan to avoid any future misbehavior. The notes from this meeting will also be documented in your file.
3. Third “strike”, you’re out! We will notify your parents that you are on your way home. You will no longer be welcome in the program. No refund.

Strikes include, but are not limited to, inappropriate language, destruction of property, physical abuse to another student or instructor.

Under no circumstances will an instructor leave the water for a discipline problem and leave the rest of the class in the water unsupervised.

**PARENTAL/GUARDIAN AGREEMENT**

My child understands that in entering this sailing camp he/she agrees to obey all camp rules as set forth by the camp director and the instructors, that my child will use utmost care in the use of the boats and equipment, and that my child will not engage in any horseplay or other disruptive behavior. My child understands that failure to arrive promptly and abide by the rules may result in suspension from the program.

I, as parent/guardian, assume full responsibility for any loss or damage, excepting loss or damage covered by insurance, that may come to any person, boat, sailboat, equipment pier, float, or other property used in conjunction with this camp as the result of improper use, negligence, violation of the rules, and other acts of sailors, or other representatives of the camp, instructional program or host location in connection herewith. I accept that the sport of sailing and the conduct of this camp entail and are subject to certain inherent risks and assume all risks on land and on the water of participation in this camp. I further agree to hold the camp, instructional program or host location, and their representatives harmless for personal injuries and/or property damage.

I understand the contents of this statement and agree to see to it that my child adheres to camp rules. I agree to assume the obligation for the expenses of repair and/or replacement of program equipment that is attributable to my child’s reckless or irresponsible behavior
