GENERAL INFORMATION

2025 Sessions available the weeks of:

June 9, June 16, June 23, July 7, July 14, July 21

(Registration fees are non-refundable.)

Camp hours: 9 a.m. – 3:30 p.m.

Early Drop-Off Option:

Drop off between 8-8:30 \$25 per child/week

Late Pick-Up Option:

Pick up between 3:30-4 p.m. \$25 per child/week. Pick up between 4-4:30 p.m. \$50 per child/week.

- Campers are divided into groups according to age and/or skill level.
- Student / Teacher ratio will not exceed 10:1.
- Each student is required to pass a swimming test prior to being allowed to go out on a boat. Swimming test will include ability to swim/tread water while putting on a life vest.
- Camp is instructional and follows daily lesson plans.
- Children are expected to pay attention, follow instructions at all times and not be disruptive.
- This is not baby-sitting. If a child misbehaves or fails to follow directions of instructors, the child will be sent home and no refunds will be given.
- During inclement weather, classes will consist of rules of sailing, sailing strategies, etc.
- Lunch, beverages and afternoon snack will be provided.

Typical Daily Schedule Monday through Friday (Schedules change depending upon weather forecast.)

- > 8:30-8:45 a.m. Arrival & check-in.
- > 9 a.m. Roll call, instructions for the day, and classes begin
- > 11:30 a.m.- 1:00 p.m. Lunch and break time times will vary
- > 1 p.m. Instruction resumes
- 3:30 p.m. Pickup

What to bring: Be sure to put your name on all items.

- ✓ Closed-toed shoes appropriate for sailing- **WATER SHOES PREFERRED NO** Flip Flops
- ✓ Sunscreen and lip protection

- ✓ Personal Flotation Device (P.F.D.) with whistle- bright colors preferred

What **NOT** to bring:

- * Food or drinks all will be provided including beverages throughout the day
- Knives or eating utensils
- ***** Bandaids or any first aid items
- Sailing books, digital devices of any kind (Cell phones may be brought to camp but *MUST* be left in backpack/bag during instruction. Cell phones being used during instruction in a non-emergency capacity will be confiscated and returned to the parent/guardian at pickup.)

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RULES AND EXPECTED BEHAVIOR

Please be sure your child reads and understands the information on this page.

1. NO STUDENT IS ALLOWED ON DOCKS OR BOATS WITHOUT U.S.C.G.A. PFD (LIFE JACKET) ON AND ZIPPED. TYPE III IS RECOMMENDED.

- 2. Proper footwear will be worn at all times, both on land and on the water.
- 3. No one is allowed on docks without supervision.
- 4. No littering on land or water. Boats and sailing areas must be kept "ship-shape".
- 5. Personal property is the responsibility of the student and not Halifax River Yacht Club or the Sailing Instructors. No electronic devices allowed on docks or boats, i.e. cell phones, iPods, etc.
- 6. No eating or chewing gum during sailing activities.
- 7. No pushing, shoving, running, hitting, profanity. No disruptive behavior, disrespectful gestures, actions or language.
- 8. No jumping off boats without instructor's permission. If instructor says you can swim, it is important to stay near your boat so you can easily get back in and also to make sure it doesn't drift away or go up on the rocks.
- 9. Stay in the area where the instructors and other students are, unless you ask the instructor's permission to leave.
- 10. Our **DISCIPLINE POLICY** (below) is strictly upheld. Every sailor is accountable for his/her actions. Be sure the policy is read and understood.

DISCIPLINE POLICY

Our discipline policy maintains that each sailor will have three chances to correct any non-rule following behavior as follows:

- 1. First "strike", your parent/guardian will be called by the instructor and the transgression will be reported. This will be recorded on your file and the Program Director will be notified.
- 2. Second "strike", you and your parents/guardians will be asked to meet with the instructor and the Program Director to discuss the first and second transgressions and to make a plan to avoid any future misbehavior. The notes from this meeting will also be documented in your file.
- 3. Third "strike", you're out! We will notify your parents/guardians that you are on your way home. You will no longer be welcome in the program. No refund.

Strikes include, but are not limited to bullying, inappropriate language, destruction of property, physical or verbal abuse to another student or instructor.

Under no circumstances will an instructor leave the water for a discipline problem and leave the rest of the class in the water unsupervised.

I further agree to hold the camp, instructional program or host location, and their representatives harmless for personal injuries and/or property damage.

I understand the contents of this statement and agree to see to it that my child adheres to camp rules. I agree to assume the obligation for the expenses of repair and/or replacement of program equipment that is attributable to my child's reckless or irresponsible behavior
